

2012 Crucial Items Checklist

- Self Defense/Hunting Equipment (Guns, Ammunition, Pepper Spray, Knives, Clubs, Bats and Slingshots, Bow and Arrows)
- Basic Cooking Utensils
 - Can Opener (not electric)

- Egg Beater (not electric)
- Whisk

- Honey/Syrups/white, brown sugars

- Basic Food Supplies
 - Rice
 - Beans
 - Flour

- Olive Oil (must have or cooking is extremely hard)

- Charcoal (for cooking and heat)
- Lighter Fluid (makes charcoal much easier to start)
- Hard Shell Water Containers (need all sizes)

- Clip-On Propane Heater

- Hand Powered Grain Mill

- Propane Tanks (be sure to store in a stable, secure place)

- Large Mantle Lamp (makes lighting for long periods of time feasible)

- Childcare Supplies
 - Diapers
 - Formula

- Diaper Rash Ointments
- Baby Oil
- Children's Aspirin

- Cleaning Tools
 - Washboard
 - Mop Bucket w/wringer
- Camping Stoves

- Multivitamins (a must-have for long term canned food diet)

- Propane Cylinder Handle (small cylinders are far too dangerous to use without one).
